
log into <u>www.ted.com</u> and choose a lecture that interests you. **Think about** the title of the lecture and what you know about the subject.

## Finding it difficult?

- **3.** A lot of the lectures have translations. You might want to watch in English and follow the transcript in your first language.

- 2. TRY to guess the meaning from the context.

to focus on the academic word list.
